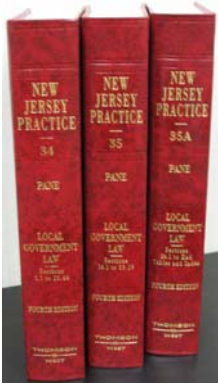


PUBLIC CONTRACT LAW
